

Dr. Alexandre Boulle is Research Director at the French National Center for Scientific Research (CNRS). He obtained a Ph. D. in Materials Science from the University of Limoges in 2002 and joined the CNRS in 2004 as a Research Associate. His research is focused on the structural and nanostructural characterization of materials by means of X-ray diffraction and diffuse X-ray scattering coupled with scientific computing, with a special interest towards thin film structures and nanostructures.
